Introduction

If I Were You is a play by Douglas James. The play is the story of an intruder. He breaks into a lonely house. A man named Gerrard lives there. He is a playwright. The intruder is a criminal. He has killed a policeman and is now on the run. This man has some physical resemblance to Gerrard. His plan is to kill Gerrard and live there under his name. But Gerrard is smarter than the criminal. He tells the intruder that he has also killed someone and the police are after him. He offers to take the intruder in his car to safety. He opens a door and tells the intruder that it goes to the garage. As soon as the intruder enters, Gerrard locks the door. In fact it is not the way to a garage but the door of a cupboard. Then he phones the police to come and arrest the intruder.

Summary of the chapter

The play starts with the playwright, Gerrard, preparing to leave his home to attend a rehearsal. After talking on the phone, he starts to pack his travel bag when he notices an intruder enter from his right side.

Gerrard notices that he has a stark resemblance to Gerrard and is holding a revolver in his hands. Thus, he learns that he is a criminal who directs him to put his hands in the air. However, Gerrard is surprisingly cool even at a gunpoint and chats pleasantly with him. Finally, the intruders make Gerrard sit on a chair.

After hearing their conversation, we learn that Gerrard is a man who lives alone and owns a car. It is clear that he is kind of mysterious in some ways because he is constantly in and out.

We see that Gerrard stays at his home and for some days isn't there.

Moreover, he only talks on the phone without really meeting his tradesmen. After learning all this, we come to know about the intruder too. He is a criminal who is mainly a jewelry robber. After killing a policeman, he is fleeing from the police and due to this resemblance to Gerrard, he plans to kill him and assume his identity to get rid of the police.

Gerrard makes out that the intruder is not so smart but only over-confident. Thus, he plans something witty and lies to the intruder. He makes up a story that Gerrard is also a criminal and murderer himself. Much similar to the intruder, the police are also after him and if he ends up killing Gerrard, the intruder will be killed either way.

So, the intruder believes his story and Gerrard convinces him to go into the garage from where they both can flee in his car. After opening the garage door, we learn that it was actually a cupboard in which Gerrard locks up the intruder and informs the police of his whereabouts. Thus, we see how a little alertness and cleverness saved Gerrard's life.

Summary in Hindi


जेरार्ड ने नोटिस किया कि वह जेरार्ड से काफी मिलता-जुलता है और अपने हाथों में एक रिवॉल्वर पकड़े हुए है। इस प्रकार, उसे पता चलता है कि वह एक अपराधी है जो उसे हवा में हाथ डालने का निर्देश देता है। हालांकि, जेरार्ड बंदूक की नोक पर भी आश्चर्यजनक रूप से शांत है और उसके साथ सुखद बातचीत करता है। अंत में, घुसपैठिया ने जेरार्ड को एक कुर्सी पर बैठा दिया।

उनकी बातचीत सुनने के बाद, हमें पता चलता है कि जेरार्ड एक ऐसा व्यक्ति है जो अकेला रहता है और एक कार का मालिक है। यह स्पष्ट है कि वह कुछ मायनों में रहस्यमय है क्योंकि वह लगातार अंदर और बाहर है। हम देखते हैं कि जेरार्ड अपने घर पर रहता है और कुछ दिनों तक वहां नहीं रहता है।

इसके अलावा, वह केवल अपने व्यापारियों से मिले बिना ही फोन पर बात करता है। यह सब जानने के बाद हमें घुसपैठिए के बारे में भी पता चलता है। वह एक अपराधी है जो मुख्य रूप से आभूषण लुटेरा है। एक पुलिसकर्मी को मारने के बाद, वह पुलिस थाना से भाग रहा है और जेरार्ड के समान होने के कारण, वह उसे मारने और पुलिस से छुटकारा पाने के लिए अपनी पहचान ग्रहण करने की योजना बना रहा है।

जेरार्ड बताते हैं कि घुसपैठिया इतना चालाक नहीं है, लेकिन केवल अति-आत्मविश्वासी है। इस प्रकार, वह कुछ मजािकया योजना बनाता है और घुसपैठिए से झूठ बोलता है। वह एक कहानी बनाता है कि जेरार्ड भी एक अपराधी और हत्यारा है। घुसपैठिए के समान ही, पुलिस भी उसके पीछे है और अगर वह जेरार्ड को मार डालता है, तो घुसपैठिए को किसी भी तरह से मार दिया जाएगा।

इसलिए, घुसपैठिया उसकी कहानी पर विश्वास करता है और जेरार्ड उसे गैरेज में जाने के लिए मना लेता है जहां से वे दोनों उसकी कार में भाग सकते हैं। गैरेज का दरवाजा खोलने के बाद, हमें पता चलता है कि यह वास्तव में एक अलमारी थी जिसमें जेरार्ड घुसपैठिए को बंद कर देता है और पुलिस को उसके ठिकाने की सूचना देता है। इस प्रकार, हम देखते हैं कि कैसे थोड़ी सी सतर्कता और चतुराई ने जेरार्ड के जीवन को बचाया।
